## LA PASTORALE

OR

First Lady and opposite Gent: advance and stop,  
then their partners advance, turn partners to places,  
The 4 Ladies move to the right into next Ladies place  
and stop, the 4 Gent<sup>s</sup> move to the left into next Gent<sup>s</sup> place  
and stop, Ladies repeat the same to right, Gent<sup>s</sup> repeat the  
same to left, all join hands and lead round to places,  
all turn partners.

## LA FINALE.

OR

First Gent: lead his partner round inside the figure  
 the 4 Ladies advance join right hands, and retire,
